**RE: Scope of the Multistate Essay Exam (MEE) for Alabama State Bar Exams  
Beginning February 2008 Exam**

The National Conference of Bar Examiners which produces the six (6) MEE questions that are included in the Alabama State Bar Exam recently introduced an expanded list of MEE test specifications or topics from which jurisdictions may select up to nine (9) MEE questions.

Beginning with the February 2008 Alabama State Bar Exam, Alabama will select and use six (6) MEE questions from the expanded MEE test topic list. This expanded list includes the following topics: Business Associations (Agency, Partnership, Corporations, and Limited Liability Companies); Conflicts of Laws; Constitutional Law; Contracts; Criminal Law & Procedure; Evidence; Family Law; Federal Civil Procedure; Real Property; Torts; Trusts and Estates; and Uniform Commercial Code (Negotiable Instruments under Article 3 and Secured Transactions under Article 9).
