

MCLE Regulation 2.7

Under Alabama MCLE Regulation 2.7 "An attorney who resides and maintains a principal office for the practice of law in another state that requires Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) and who can demonstrate compliance with the Mandatory CLE requirements of his or her principal state of practice is exempt from these rules, except as provided in Rule 5 and 9.
