1. Bar Member Volunteer Efforts for Hurricane Victims

- Complimentary 30-day lexis.com ID for Alabama Bar volunteers providing pro bono legal aid to the community
 - Menus built around anticipated key legal issues and corresponding LexisNexis content
- A certain number of computers are available through the LexisNexis Cares PC Donation Program for use by volunteer force providing pro bono legal aid
- Eligible LexisNexis (Alabama) employees asked to staff the Alabama hotline, providing legal consultation to disaster relief victims
