## **PURPOSE & SCOPE**

The committee will provide liaison services to the State government; facilitate the function of the Legislature in passing laws which affect the judicial systems or the Alabama State Bar. Further, the Governmental Liaison Committee will provide mediation or facilitation services at the request of members of the State government to help bring about constructive resolution of proposed legislation or to deal with problems of public concern.

The committee will be organized so as to divide up the responsibility for reading and reviewing proposed legislation to monitor legislation which may be of interest or consequence to either the judicial system or the Alabama State Bar.

The committee shall also organize and maintain a Panel of Neutrals of distinguished Alabamians who are willing to serve, if requested, in an advisory capacity to State government.
