

PURPOSE AND SCOPE


This task force was created in 2017 to examine, enhance, and develop avenues to foster relationships between the various segments of our bar. The task force made substantial progress last year and provided an extensive report at the end of the bar year outlining activities that the Alabama State Bar could undertake to improve appreciation of, and participation, in bar activities by its members. This year, the task force shall work to implement the recommendations contained in that report.

The task force may divide itself into such working groups as may be necessary to effectively carry out its functions. The chairperson shall appoint a chair for any working group. The task force shall elect from its membership a secretary who shall be responsible for a written record of its actions. The secretary, or a designee, shall keep minutes of all meetings of the task force, and of all working groups thereof. The original of the minutes shall be filed with the Alabama State Bar within 14 days after each meeting to be made a part of the task force's file.

The task force shall meet regularly and provide timely written interim reports to the President. The task force shall submit a comprehensive written report of its findings, recommendations, and proposals, and the success of implementation thereof, including a recommendation of whether the task force should be continued for another year, no later than June 1, 2019.

The task force shall meet at the call of either or both co-chairs. The Alabama State Bar, through its designated staff liaison, will assist the task force in carrying out its purpose.
