Applications must be completed and received by the Bar by 5:00 p.m. on <u>October 21, 2019</u>. Successful applicants will be notified the week of December 16, 2019. Class 15 will consist of no more than 30 participants.

Applicants must be in good standing with the Alabama State Bar and have practiced law for not less than 5 years and for not more than 16 years as of January 1, 2020 (based upon first admission to any state bar). **Mandatory attendance** is required for the following: Orientation and Training Session 15.1 – January 22, 2020 at 1:00 pm – January 24, 2020 at 3:00 pm, Orange Beach, Alabama; Session 15.2 – February 20, 2020 at 6:30 pm – February 21, 2020 at 5:00 pm, Tuscaloosa; Session 15.3 – March 25, 2020 at 6:30 pm – March 27, 2020 at 5:00 pm, Montgomery; Session 15.4 – April 15, 2020 at 6:30 pm – April 16, 2020 at 10:00 pm, Birmingham, with Graduation Ceremony at 7:00 pm preceded by Cocktail Party and Dinner at 6:00 pm. Spouse or one guest is invited to attend graduation without charge. Applicants are encouraged to apply only if they commit to attend all sessions.

Your application should contain the following components assembled in this order:

- (1) This application form, completed and signed by you and your employer if applicable.
- (2) Your Professional Resume or curriculum vitae (not to exceed three pages) that includes the following information:
  - a. education, work history and a short description of your practice of law (practice area, emphasis, etc.);
  - b. bar involvement state and/or local (include any offices held and section/committee participation);
  - c. business and/or professional organization involvement (include any offices held); and
  - d. civic, charitable and/or community involvement (include any offices held);
  - (3) A narrative summary (not to exceed six pages, double-spaced) that addresses:
    - a. why you should be selected as a participant in Class 15 of the Leadership Forum;
    - b. what you consider to be your most important contribution to the legal profession;
    - c. what you consider to be your most important contribution to the community; and
    - d. what you hope to gain from participation in Class 15 of the Leadership Forum;
- (4) One **substantial** letter of recommendation from someone not affiliated with your current employer. You are strongly encouraged to choose a recommender who knows you well and who can provide us with a detailed sense of who you are and why you would both contribute to and benefit from participation in Class 15 of the Leadership Forum. Impersonal letters of recommendation and those that merely restate the accomplishments listed on your personal resume are not helpful in the selection process. To assist your recommender, you should provide him or her with the "Special Note to Recommenders of Leadership Forum Applicants," which is attached to this application form.

Impersonal letters of recommendation and those that merely restate the accomplishments listed on the applicant's personal resume are less helpful in the selection process. Your letter of recommendation may be any length.
