ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING WUHAN VIRUS (COVID-19)

The Alabama Supreme Court having issued an Administrative Order on March 13, 2020 whereby it ordered the suspension of “[a]ll in-person proceedings” through April 16, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED that all in-person proceedings, to include trial, and hearings, previously scheduled by the Circuit, District and Juvenile Courts of the 41st Judicial Circuit which are set between March 31, 2020 and April 8, 2020 are continued and will be reset by those respective Courts.

Additional orders will be issued regarding proceedings which are scheduled after April 8, 2020.

The Circuit and District Courts and the Circuit Clerk’s office will remain open during this period with limited personnel for the purpose of receiving emergency motions, Protection from Abuse Petitions, and any time sensitive matters.



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING WUHAN VIRUS (Coronavirus)


The Alabama Supreme Court having issued an Administrative Order on March 13, 2020 whereby it ordered the suspension of “[a]ll in-person proceedings” through April 16, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED that all in person proceedings, to include trials and hearings, previously scheduled in the Circuit, District and Juvenile Courts of the 41st Judicial Circuit which are set between March 16, 2020 and March 30, 2020 are continued and will be reset by those respective Courts.

Within the next ten days an additional Order shall be issued regarding proceedings which have been scheduled between March 31, 2020 and April 16, 2020.

The Circuit and District Courts and the Circuit Clerk’s office will remain open during this period with limited personnel for the purpose of receiving emergency motions, Protection from Abuse Petitions, and any time sensitive matters.
