**STANDING ORDER REGARDING COURT PROCEEDINGS FOR THE 29<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL  
CIRCUIT FOR DATES APRIL 17, 2020 – APRIL 30, 2020  
IN RE: COVID-19 PANDEMIC EMERGENCY RESPONSE**

This matter comes before the Court on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2020, based on the Court's own motion and the Court having received an Administrative Order #5 Extending Orders and Deadlines Concerning the Suspending In-Person Proceedings Until April 30, 2020 and based upon said Order and consideration of the same, the Court finds as follows:

1. The April 14, 2020, Domestic Violence docket for all incarcerated Defendants shall be conducted via closed circuit television at 9:00 a.m. in Judge Hollingsworth's courtroom at 9:00 a.m. All defendants that are not incarcerated are hereby continued until June 10, 2020.
2. The April 17, 2020, Dependency (Sylacauga) docket is hereby continued to May 15, 2020.
3. The April 20, 2020, Delinquency (Sylacauga) docket is hereby continued to May 26, 2020.
4. The April 21, 2020, Child Support (Talladega) docket for all incarcerated Defendants shall be conducted via closed circuit television at 9:00 a.m. in Judge Hollingsworth's courtroom at 9:00 a.m. All other child support cases are hereby continued to May 19, 2020.
5. The April 22, 2020, Misdemeanor Review and Misdemeanor Dockets for all incarcerated Defendants shall be conducted via closed circuit television at 9:00 a.m. in Judge Hollingsworth's courtroom at 9:00 a.m. All defendants that are not incarcerated are hereby continued to May 29, 2020.
6. The April 30, 2020 Child Support (Sylacauga) docket for all incarcerated Defendants shall be conducted via closed circuit television at 9:00 a.m. in Judge Hollingsworth's courtroom at 9:00 a.m. All other child support cases are hereby continued to May 28, 2020.
7. Any Termination of Parental Rights hearings that are scheduled during this two (2) week extension shall proceed in-person (as TPRs are exceptions to the No In-Person Proceedings) on the day, time and location set by the Court.
8. If anyone would like to have a hearing BEFORE the continued court dates, for all cases, you should file a Motion Requesting a Hearing and the hearing would be set up via ZOOM. Once the hearing is scheduled via ZOOM, the Court **MUST** have e-mail addresses for **ALL** parties at least one (1) week prior to the hearing.
