ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER – SHELBY COUNTY COURTHOUSE (18<sup>th</sup>  
Judicial Circuit)

WHEREAS the Supreme Court of Alabama has entered ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #6: EXTENDING ORDERS AND DEADLINES CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF IN-PERSON PROCEEDINGS THROUGH MAY 15, 2020, entered this date, the undersigned Presiding Circuit Judge does hereby ORDER, ADJUDGE and DECREE as follows:

- 1) The Courts and all State and County offices in the Shelby County Courthouse shall remain OPEN and continue to maintain regular business operations, but the courthouse facility shall be CLOSED to the public through May 15, 2020.
- 2) On May 18, 2020, it is anticipated that the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit will resume in-person hearings in a three-phase process to be set out via separate order.
- 3) Jury trials for the week of June 8, 2020, are hereby CANCELLED pursuant to the Supreme Court of Alabama's suspension of all jury trials through June, 2020.

This Order is effective immediately and shall remain in effect through May 15, 2020. All previous Administrative orders entered in the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit not in conflict with this Order remain in full force and effect.

It is ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be spread upon the minutes of the Court and a copy shall be provided to the Administrative Office of Courts.
