ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Because of continued concerns related to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), the Supreme Court's Order of March 13, 2020, April 30, 2020 and May 13, 2020 and after conferring with the Circuit Judges of the 19th Circuit, in an abundance of caution, effective immediately and until close of business on Monday, May 25, 2020, no in-person hearings shall be held in any court in the 19th Judicial Circuit excepting those outlined in the Supreme Court's Order of March 13, 2020.

Attendance during all court proceedings permitted under the Supreme Court's Order of March 13, 2020 is limited to the following individuals only:

1. Parties (and parents accompanying juveniles)
2. Counsel for the parties
3. Witnesses as needed
4. Court personnel
5. The District Attorney and his staff
6. Court security and law enforcement officers
7. The press

Except as specifically directed by a circuit or district judge, Courthouse security officers are directed to exclude any individual(s) not specifically listed above from admission to the second floor of the Autauga and Elmore County Courthouses or Judicial Complex and the third floor of the Chilton County Courthouse during the period identified above.
