

**IN THE TWENTY-THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

As a result of the State of Emergency Declared by Governor Ivey and the Administrative Order of Chief Justice Tom Parker of the Alabama Supreme Court dated March 13, 2020 and the safety of Alternative Sentencing personnel, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

At the discretion of Alternative Sentencing any inmate in the Madison County jail currently on Active Work Release may be placed on electronic monitoring upon the following conditions:

1. The Defendant must appear to answer and submit to the Orders and process of the Court having jurisdiction of this case as directed.
2. The Defendant must refrain from committing any criminal offense.
3. The Defendant may not depart from the State of Alabama without leave of the Court having jurisdiction of this case.
4. The Defendant must promptly notify Alternative Sentencing of any change of the Defendant's address.
5. All conditions of work release shall be followed in addition to the requirements of electronic monitoring.

The provisions of this release order may be revoked or modified by the Court for cause. This Order shall continue in force and effect until the dismissal, acquittal or conviction of the Defendant of the charges, unless revoked or modified by the Court. Upon report of a violation of any one of the above conditions, a warrant for the Defendant's arrest will immediately issue.

At the discretion of Work Release, the defendant may serve the remainder of the ordered sentence on electronic monitoring as a condition of work release
