
WHEREAS the Supreme Court of Alabama has issued an Administrative Order Extending Orders and Deadlines Concerning the Suspension of In-Person Proceedings Through May 15, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred upon me as Presiding Judge of the Thirty-Eighth Judicial Circuit, Jackson County, Alabama.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

1. The court hereby extends through May 15, 2020, any deadlines set to expire in the administrative orders of the undersigned and the orders shall remain in full force and effect through May 15, 2020.
2. The courts of the Thirty-Eighth Judicial Circuit shall continue to utilize available technologies such as teleconferencing and videoconferencing to conduct hearings when it is practical and feasible to do so.
3. The Clerk shall provide the Alabama Administrative Office of Courts with a copy of this order, and a copy shall also be provided to members of the Jackson County Bench and Bar and the Jackson County Sheriff.
