PURPOSE AND SCOPE


The Elections Committee Task Force is established to provide a comprehensive review of the Alabama State Bar Rules Governing Election and Selection of President-Elect and Members of the Board of Commissioners.

The task force shall review the entirety of existing election rules and best practices for candidates. This review shall include but not be limited to the following: election procedure, qualifications, nomination criteria, and methods of campaign communications with membership. The task force shall further ensure all existing or proposed modifications to any election rule are timely, effective, and efficient to the election process.

The task force will then provide recommendations to the Board of Bar Commissioners in the event any changes, deletions, or amendments to the existing rules are warranted.

The Alabama State Bar, through its designated staff liaison, will assist the task force in conducting the above stated purpose.
